## HAUC(UK)Training and Accreditation Working Group (TAWG)

## Purpose

To facilitate consultation and make representation to HAUC(UK) on matters relating to training and accreditation with regard to the New Roads and Streets Works Act 1991.

## Terms of Reference

- Determine the assessment strategy for operatives working on the highway and supervisors responsible for the supervision of the street works
- Regularly review the assessment standards (The Standards) in the light of changes to:
  - o Codes of Practice and HAUC(UK) Advice Notes relating to street works,
  - o Excavation and reinstatement techniques/materials and
  - New technologies.
- Produce statistical analysis on registrations of operatives/supervisors
- Work with Awarding Bodies to ensure qualifications are assessed in line with legislation
- Report back to HAUC(UK) progress on all issues
- Provide support o the Awarding Bodies
- Provide advice to the industry
